Expressions of Interest Process

First wave of Implementation

- 77 EOIs received last month
- 9 selected to progress to Business Case Development
- Successful proposals include the development of Integrated Family Health Centres, more nurse-led services, including a greater role for nurse practitioners and the development of more multi-disciplinary teams. The proposals also plan to merge some PHOs
- Opportunities over time for patients to gain access to a wider range of health services, closer to home
